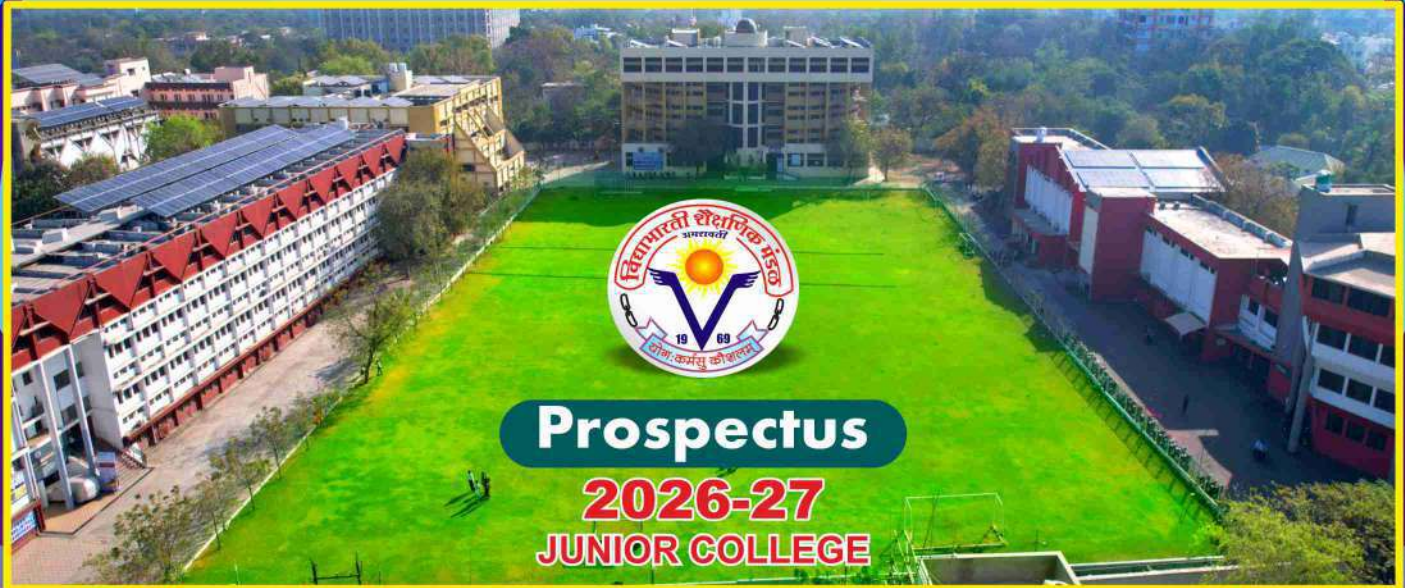

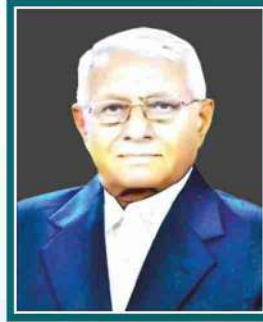

## How to Apply

1. Applicants selected by the Online Procedure shall apply for admission only through the prescribed application form accompanying this prospectus.
2. Applicants securing less than 40% marks in SSC examination will not be given admission in science.
3. Completely filled application form will only be accepted.
4. Documents to be submitted at the time of admission :
  - a) Transfer Certificate (Original).
  - b) Photostat copy of Transfer Certificate.
  - c) Photostat copy of Mark sheet.
  - d) Photostat copy of Caste Certificate.
  - e) Photostat copy of Aadhar Card
5. Original copies of all certificates will have to be shown at the time of admission.
6. Subjects (optional subjects) once offered will not be allowed to change after 30<sup>th</sup> Sept 2025
7. Latest Passport size photograph will have to be pasted on Admission form at the time of admission.
8. All decisions regarding admission will be taken by the admission committee. Final decision will be of the Principal.
9. Full fees should be paid at the time of admission which is not refundable.

## Hostel Facility for Girls

Vidya Bharati Shaikshanik Mandal, Amravati was established by Late Hon'ble Dr. D. R. Shekhawat, an eminent educationist, as a Founder President and Hon'ble Smt. Pratibhatai Patil, The First Lady President of India as the Former President of the society. The management works with missionary zeal to promote women empowerment through quality education. In order to make the stay of outstation Girls the college has built a spacious "Pratibha Women's Hostel" Which is more Secured and Comfortable equipped with all basic and modern amenities in the most secure environment of Vidya Bharati Mahavidyalaya, Amravati. It is heartening to note that the girl students at present are out -numbering and out-smarting their boy's counterparts in several fields by utilizing these facilities to their optimal potential. The founder members are indeed very delighted to see that their dream of educating and empowering women is being fulfilled.

A separate application form must be submitted for admission to the hostel after seeking admission in the college.

## Our Special Features

- **VBSP (Vidya Bharati Special Pattern):** This is a special feature of our Jr. college which is being practised for several years. In the beginning of the session the college selects top 50 students through a screening test. These students are guided for special tests. Two tests (unit wise) are held in July and September. The papers are evaluated by experienced staff and the students are given individual guidance and counselling. In the month of November and December, these students appear for full paper test based on board pattern. Then they are provided with extra coaching, periodic tests and regular guidance that help students to secure higher ranks in the Board Exam.
- **Remedial Coaching:** The college runs classes for slow learners so as to instill confidence and learning spirit.
- **Students Counselling:** Free counseling is provided to the students through Student Counseling Cell in order to provide special guidance and encouragement.



- Junior college timings are from 7.20 am to 1.30 pm (Timings can change as per schedule).
- As per the HSC Board rules, the students having an attendance below 75% will not be permitted to appear for HSC Examination.
- Students will not miss classes while in the college & will not leave the college campus during the college hours without prior permission of the Principal/ Head of the Department.
- Every student should have Identity Card & must wear in prominently visible way in the campus.
- Student should be properly and neatly dressed with prescribed college uniform on all working days except Wednesday. On Wednesday color dress other than T-Shirts & Jeans can be used.
- Dress code: For Girls- Salwar Kurta. For boys- Shirt & Pant. The colours of College Uniform should be in accordance with the norms prescribed by the college authorities.
- Students are prohibited from organizing any kind of programme or forming associations/ organizations without the prior permission of the Principal.
- Students will not use foul or offensive language.
- Students will not litter in or outside the campus.
- Strict action will be taken against students found using narcotic substances and behaving inappropriately in the campus.
- Students are expected to be environment friendly.
- Bullying, aggression or violence in any form is a gross misconduct for which the college will take strict disciplinary action if required.
- Student should make use of Library books, classroom furniture & fans, laboratory equipments & the college property carefully. In case of any damage, students will have to pay penalty individually or collectively as the case may be.
- The use of Mobile Phone is strictly prohibited in the campus.



According to Maharashtra Prohibition of Ragging Act, No. 33, 15th May 1999, Ragging is strictly prohibited. Ragging means a display of disorderly conduct, the doing of any act which causes or is likely to cause physical or psychological harm or raise the apprehension or fear or shame or embarrassment in a student in any educational institute and includes-

- i) Teasing, abusing, threatening or playing practical jokes on, or causing hurt to any student.
- ii) Asking a student to do any act or to perform something which a student will not, in the ordinary course, willingly do. Ragging within or outside of any educational institute is prohibited.

**Penalty for Ragging:** Whoever directly or indirectly commits, participates in, abets or propagates ragging within or outside any educational institution shall on conviction, be punished with imprisonment for a term which may extend to two years and shall also be liable to fine which may extend to ten thousand rupees.

**Dismissal of students:** Any student convicted of an offence under section 4 of ragging Act No. 33 shall be dismissed from the educational institution and such a student shall not be admitted in any other educational institution for a period of five years from the date of order of such dismissal.

**Suspension of student:** If the student is found guilty in such cases his / her admission shall be terminated from the institution.

## Co-curricular and Extra-curricular Activities

**Vidya Bharti GEMS:** Vidya Bharti GEMS under the Chairmanship of Mrs. Manjari R. Shekhawat is a society regulated by V.B.S.M. & managed by the student fraternity to conduct various student - centric, Co-curricular & Extra-curricular activities. It aims at grooming & all-round development of the students enrolled with the institution. The Vidya Bharti GEMS plans and organizes various activities on the campus and off the campus. It also covers extension activities and provides opportunities to the students to interact with the society. It encompasses facets viz. sensitization issues, gender equity, environmental awareness, cultural programs, inculcation of social values and their commitment to the society, etc. To execute the goals of Vidya Bharti GEMS, following committees are formed which function throughout the academic year.



- **Club Malhar (Performing Arts) :** Club Malhar is formed to encourage students to participate in various performing arts activities like poetry, dance, drama, music, creative arts, etc.
- **Young Minds (Literary Events) :** Young minds organizes literary events like elocution, quiz, debate, related seminars, etc.
- **Social Outreach & Enabling Centre :** SOEC conducts various social activities like NGOs visits, adoption of village, visiting blind school and orphanages etc.
- **Pratibha Women's Studies Centre :** The programmes related to health, hygiene, empowerment of woman, personality development, etc. for girl students and are organized under aegis of this centre.
- **Enviro-Club :** Enviro club strives to make the society aware in general & students in particular in regard to environmental issues such as pollution control, energy, soil & water conservations, etc. It organizes programme of sensitization, tree plantation, etc.
- **Club Sadhana (Holistic Development) :** Apart from physical health, mental health is equally important. Hence it looks after the mental health & peace of mind of the students as well as the society as an extension activity through workshops on yoga, meditation, etc.
- **Club Shourya (Games and Sports) :** The students not participating in NSS, NCC or Inter-Collegiate Sports Competitions are required to attend the classes of physical training, self defence courses for girls, etc.
- **Club Manthan (Skill Development) :** Club Manthan organizes various workshops on personality developments, oratory skills, foreign languages, etc. for the students.
- **Games and Sports : (In-Charge: Dr. Sabir S. Ali)** The college has a vast cultivated play field with Spectators' Gallery. Coaching for various games such as Ball-badminton, Softball, Hockey, Football, Korfbal, Cricket & Kabaddi etc. is imparted to students. The students may participate in various sports competitions only after being selected by the College Selection Committee. Indoor games facilities for Table Tennis, Badminton, Carrom, Chess etc. are available.
- **NCC : Teacher In-charge, Associated NCC Officer (Female) Major Dr. Mithilesh Rathore and (Male) Lt. Mr. C.C. Jadhao :** The college has NCC Unit. Students with special talent and distinctions can get the benefit of the State Govt. and Chief Minister's Scholarship Schemes. The cadet who has completed graduation and passed 'C' Certificate Examination with at least Grade 'B' may be exempted from written examination for the Officer's Post in the Army, conducted by the Service Selection Board. Admission to NCC Unit should be confirmed in the month of July.

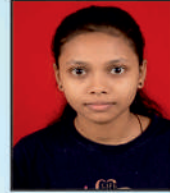

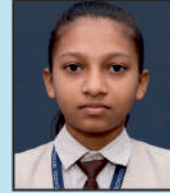
